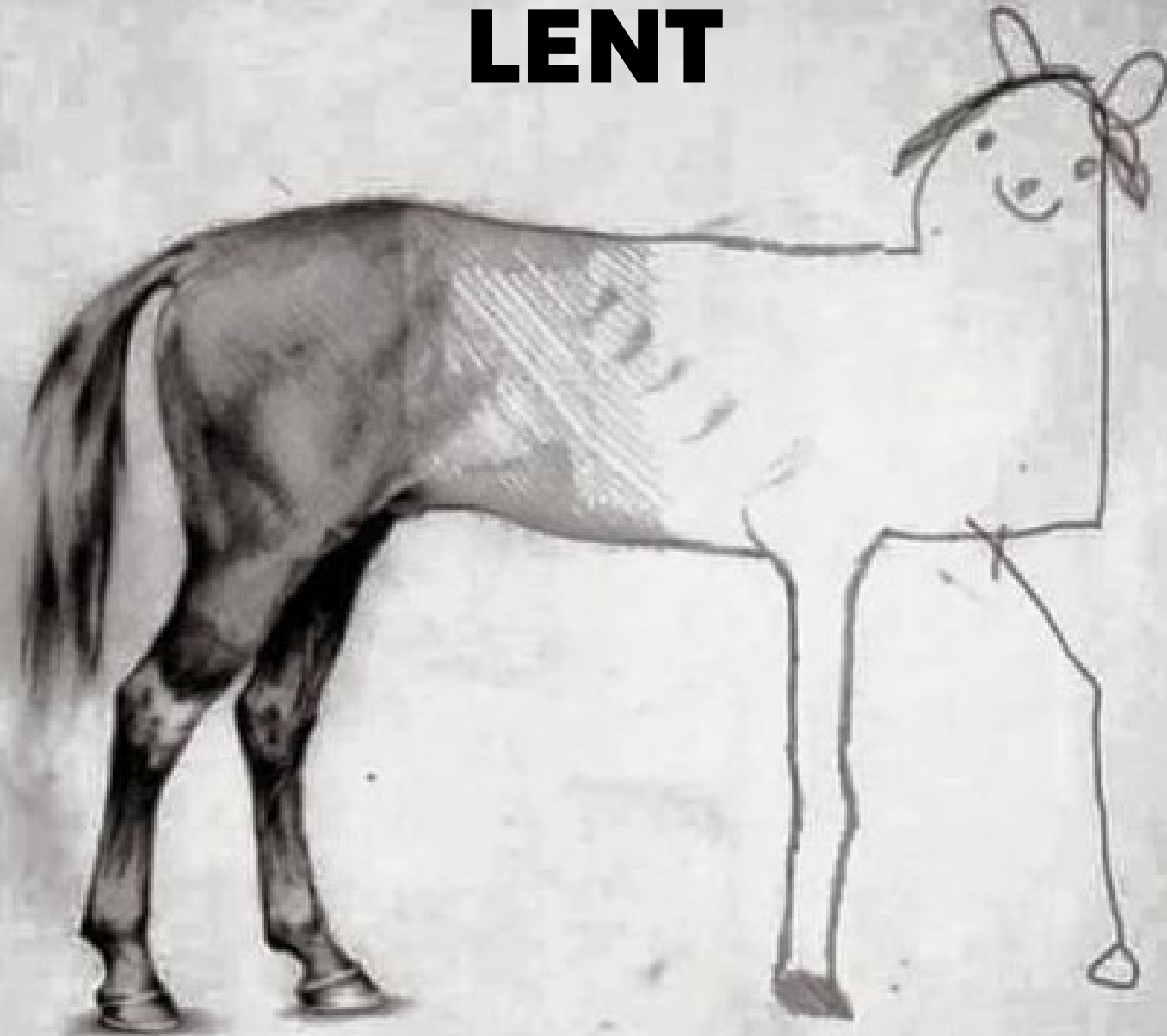

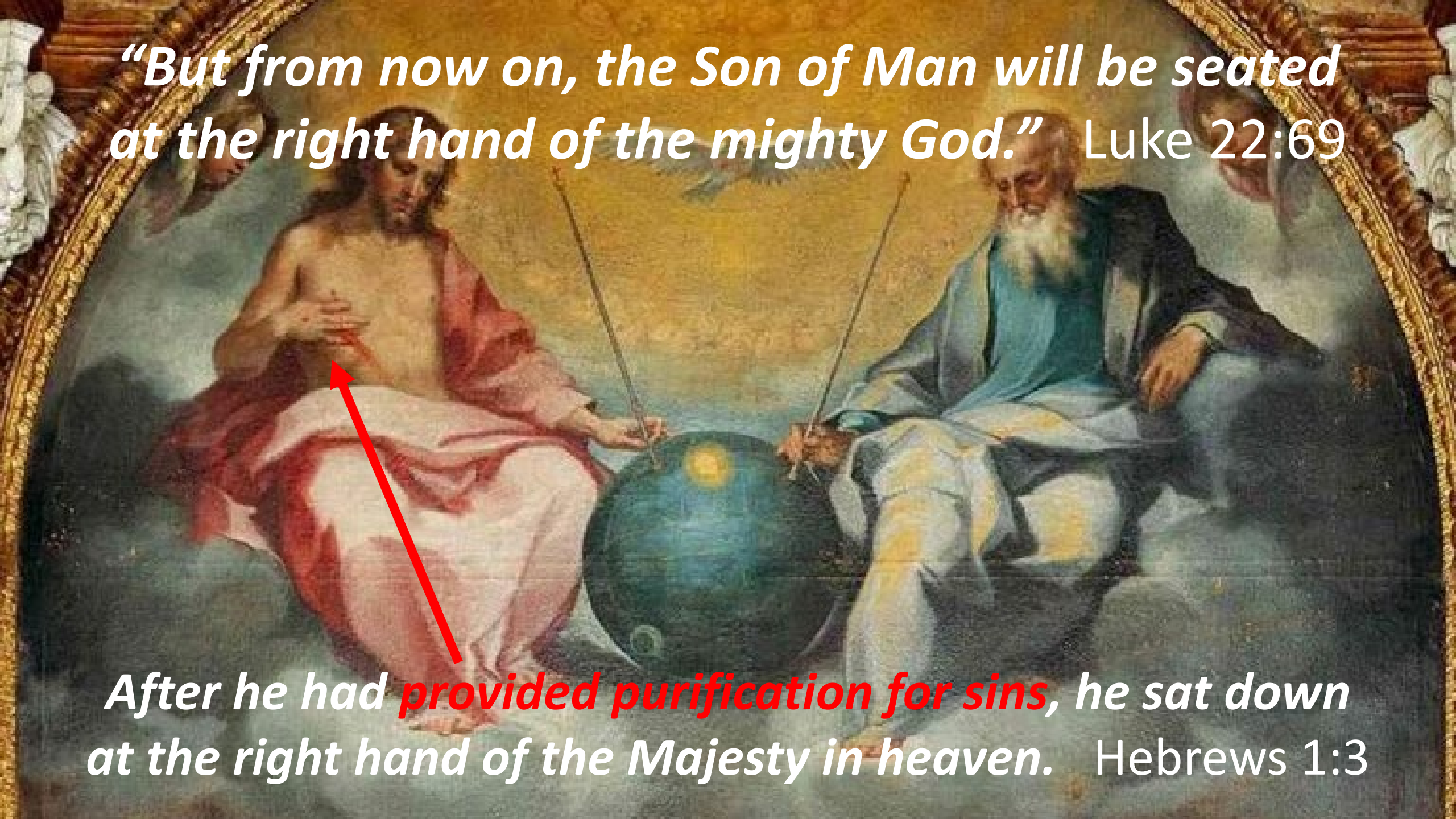
They spoke about his departure [Exodus], which he was about to bring to fulfillment at Jerusalem. 9:31

As the time approached for him to be taken up to heaven, Jesus resolutely set out for Jerusalem. 9:51

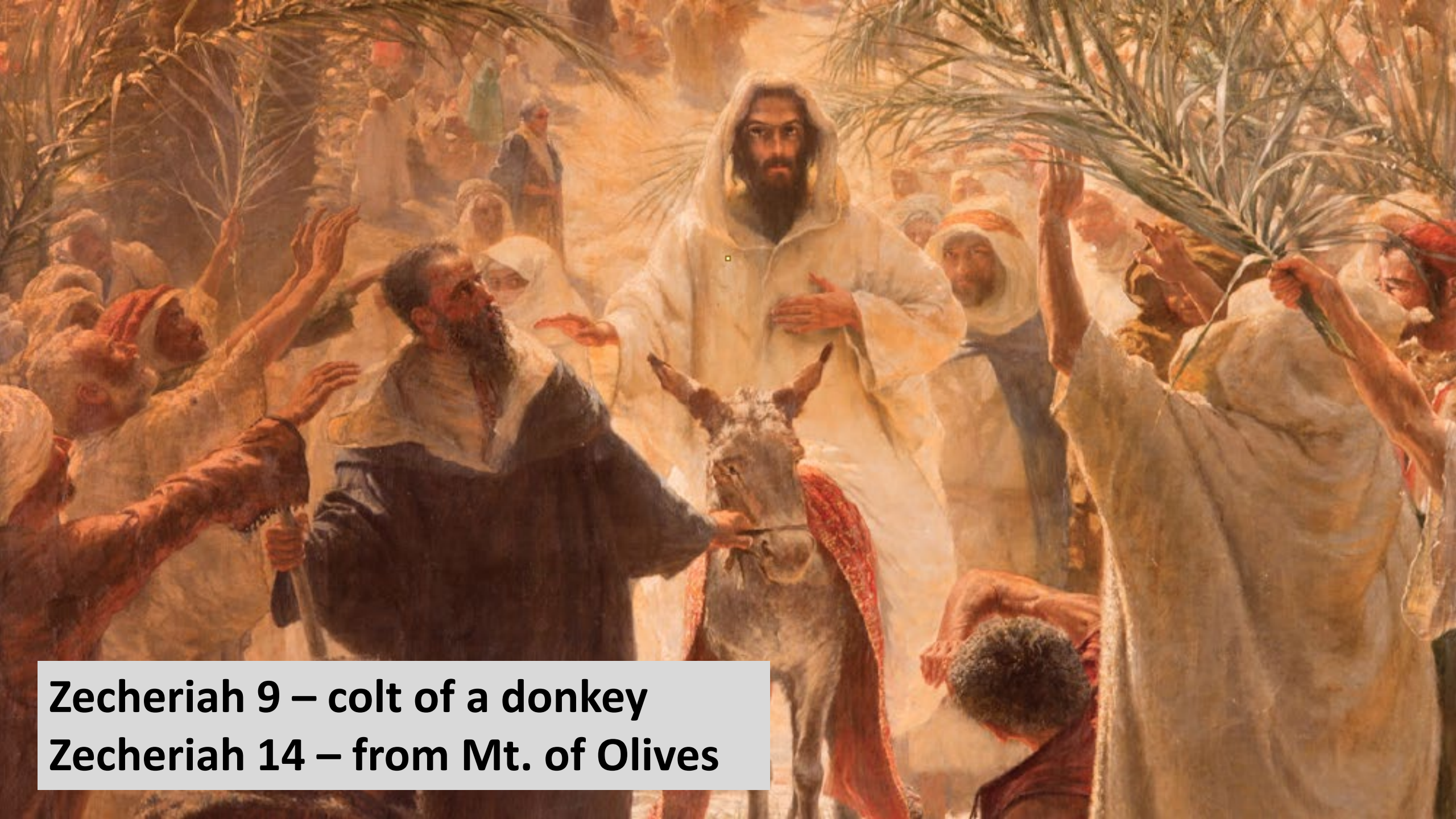
Jerusalem, Jerusalem, you who kill the prophets and stone those sent to you. 13:34

“But from now on, the Son of Man will be seated at the right hand of the mighty God.” Luke 22:69



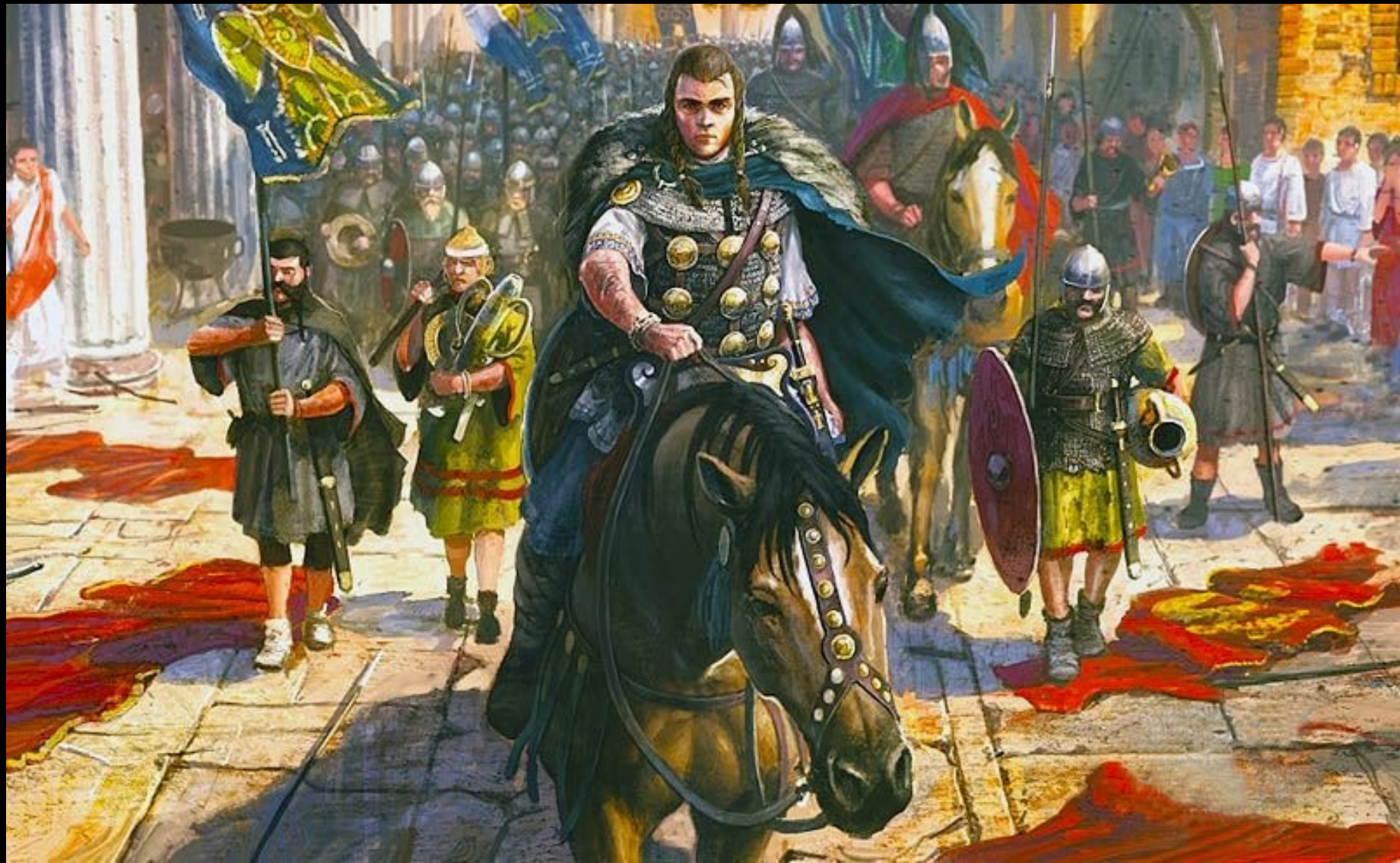

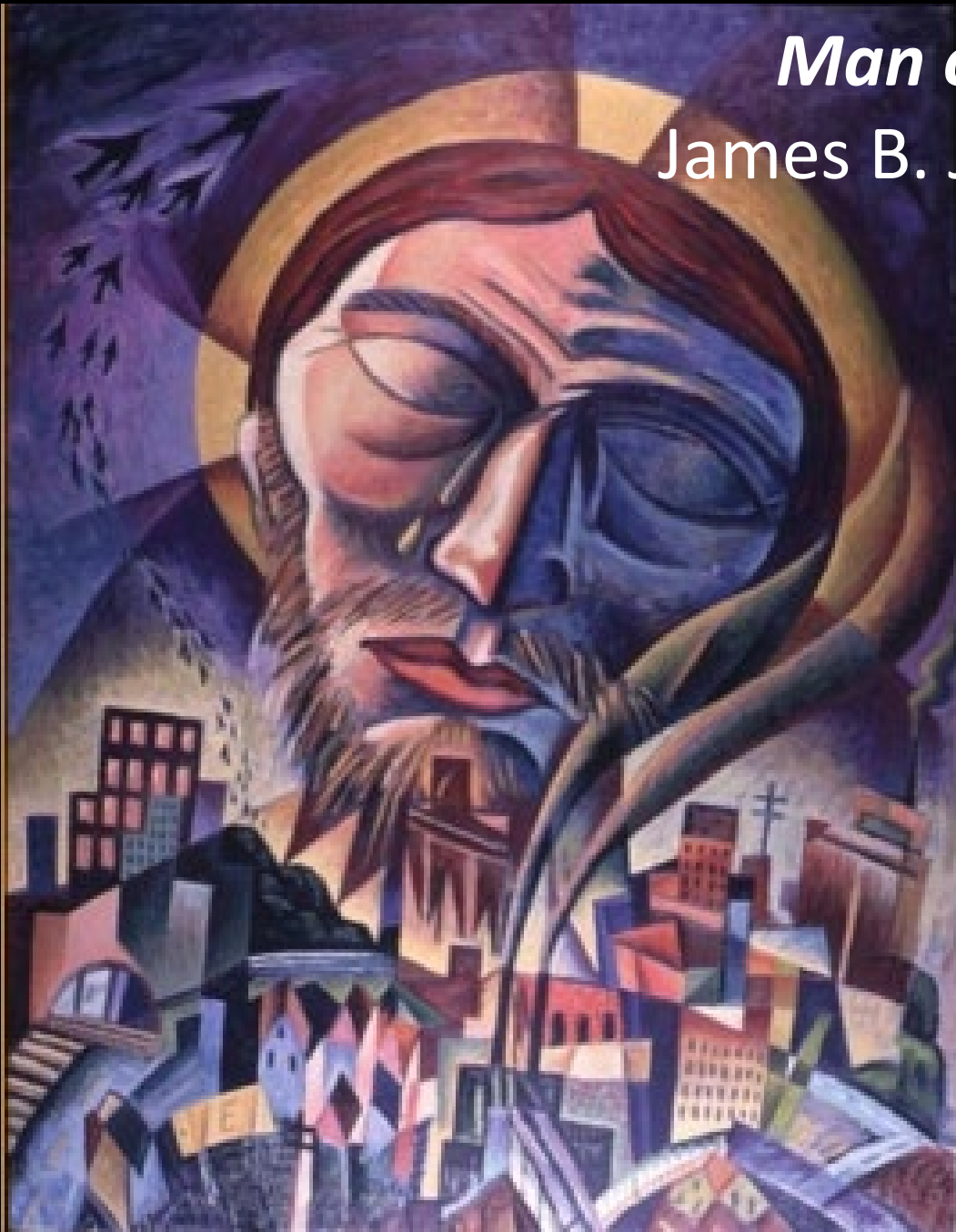

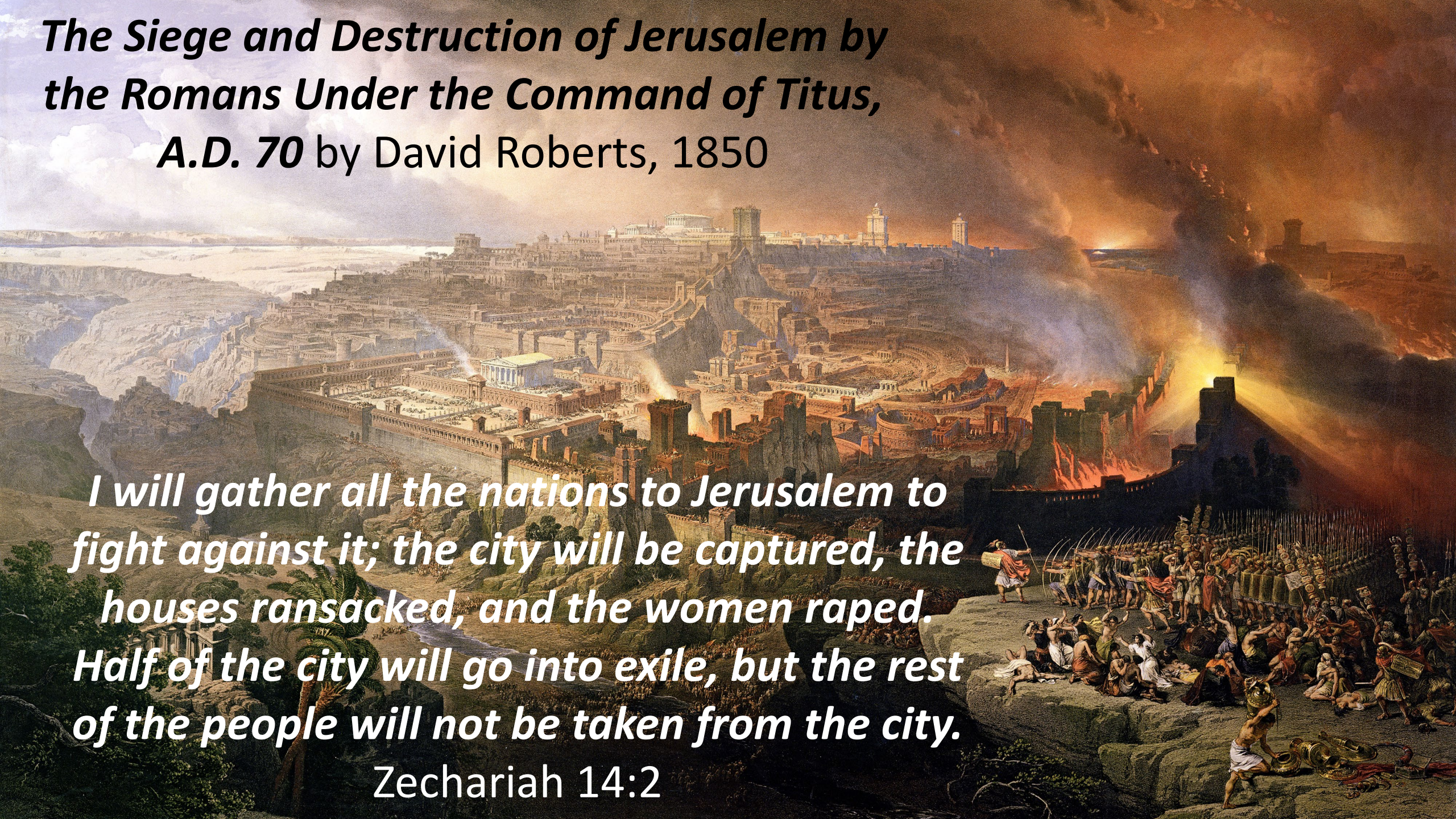

There was a written notice above him, which read: this is the king of the jews. Luke 23:38

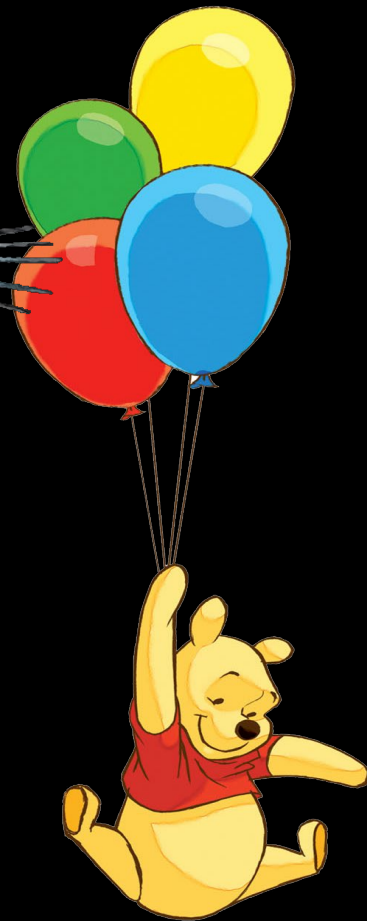
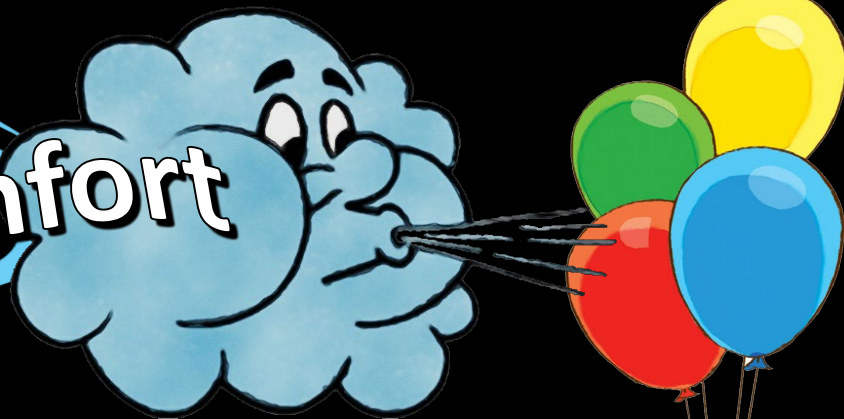

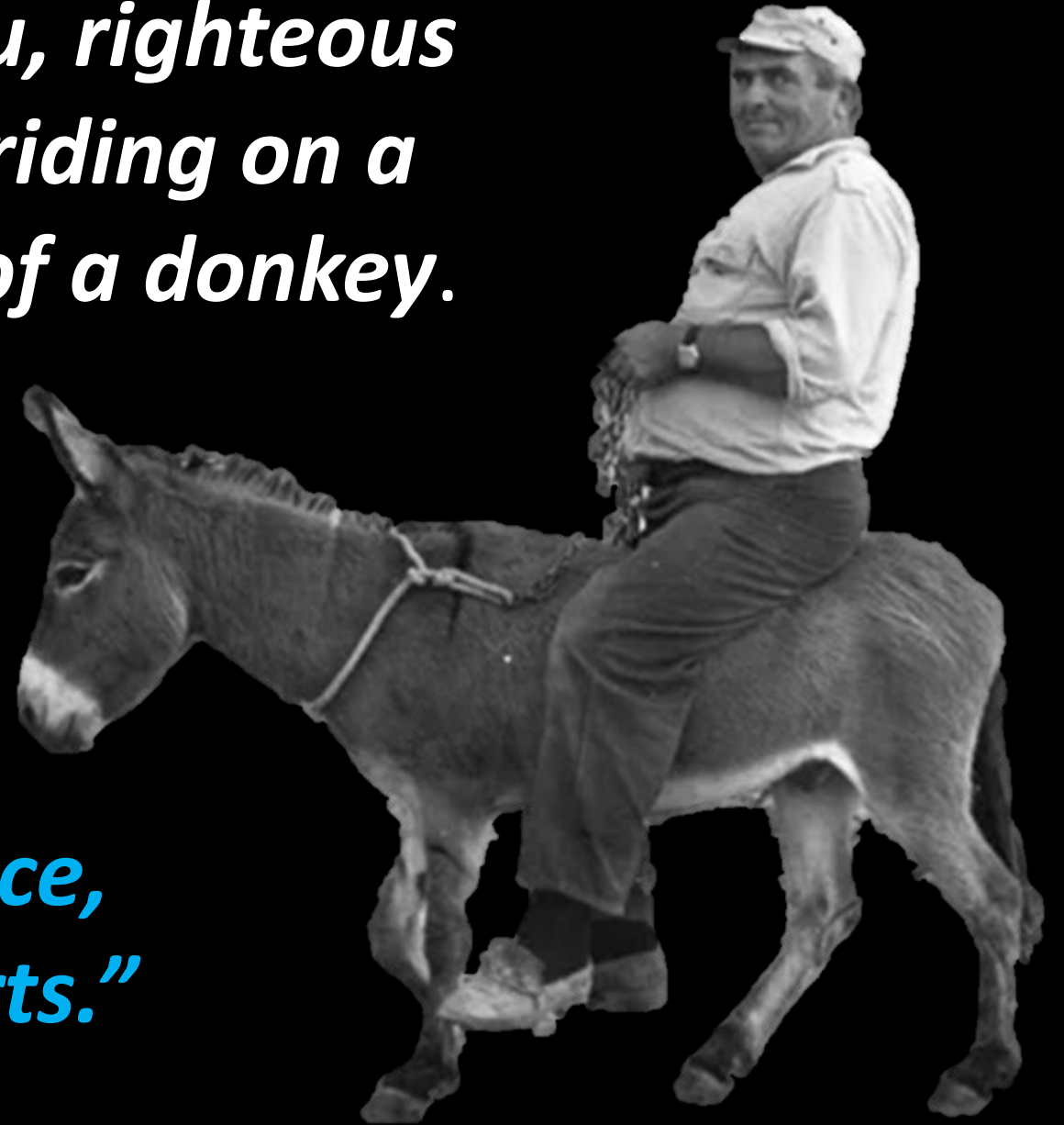
